**To Appropriate Unappropriated Waters of the State of California**  
 FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES

I, the town of Moss Beach (Post office) San Mateo County of San Mateo State of California do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described unappropriated waters of the State of California, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is San Vicente Creek located in San Mateo County, tributary of \_\_\_\_\_

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one cubic foot per second (One cubic foot per second equals 45 meters<sup>3</sup> inches)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is for irrigation purposes

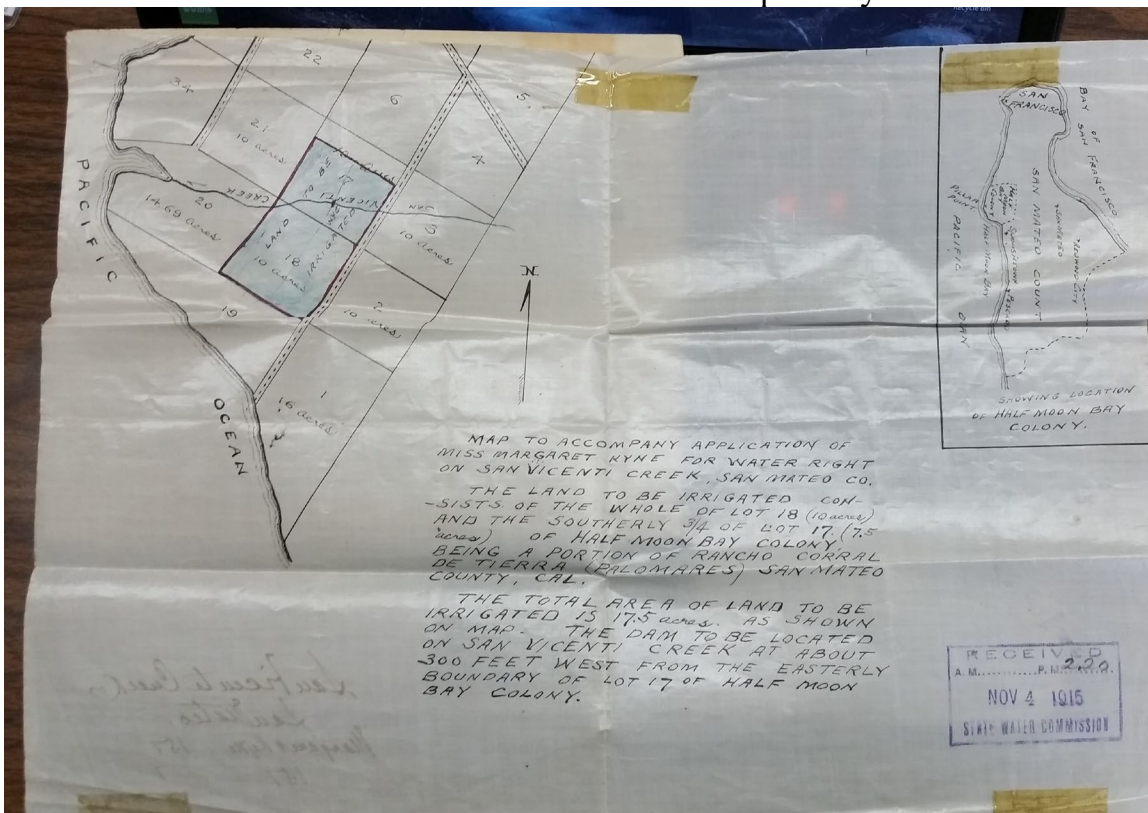
4. The point of diversion is located on lot 17 as the same is designated upon a that certain map entitled, Half Moon Bay Colony, being a portion of Rancho Corral de Tierra (Palomares) which map was filed in the office of the county recorder San Mateo Co., April 3rd, 1979, the original of which map is of record therein in Map Book D, at page 5 and a copy thereof is recorded in Map Book 1, page 22.

5. The main ditch to be one-eighth miles in length, terminating in the ote 17 & 18, Half Moon Bay Colony of Sec. \_\_\_\_\_ R. \_\_\_\_\_ M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Kyne Ditch

These applications for the rights to previously unappropriated state water can include maps, protests of the appropriations and other treasures for those researching in the county. They date from the 1870s to the 1950s and include applications by both individuals and companies (farms, land developers and water).

## PROTEST BLANK

**R.W. Krobitzsch**

I, **R.W. Krobitzsch**, of the County of **San Mateo**, State of **California**, have read carefully a copy of, or a notice relative to Application **APP. 9678** of **Sky Honda Mutual Water Co.** to appropriate from **San Gregoria Creek** at a point **Sec Twp. 65 R 4 T M D N**

It is desired to protest against the approval thereof because to the best of **our** information and belief the proposed appropriation will result in injury to **us** as follows: **for the last 30 years at the Driver Ranch west of San Gregoria on the San Gregoria Creek we have been pumping on the land adjacent to the creek from April 1st to Nov. 1st every year for irrigation purposes from 200 to 250 gals. per min. day & night in order to irrigate over 100 acres of farm crops. If any more water than is at present being taken from the creek it will make it impossible for us to get enough water for irrigation purposes to properly grow our crops, causing extensive losses.**

Protestant claims a right to the use of water from the source from which applicant proposes to divert, which right is based upon \_\_\_\_\_

The extent of present and past use of water by protestant or his predecessors in interest from this source is as follows: \_\_\_\_\_

NOTE.—Protests must be filed within the time allowed by the Division as stated in the published notice relative to an application or such further time as may be allowed.

Use and Location of Diversion Works

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is: **Pescadero Creek**  
located in **San Mateo** County, tributary to **Pacific Ocean**

2. The amount of water which applicant desires to appropriate under this application is as follows:

(a) For diversion to be directly applied to beneficial use without storage **0.5** cubic feet per second, to be diverted from **January 1st** to **December 31st** of each season.

(b) For diversion to be stored temporarily and later applied to beneficial use \_\_\_\_\_ acre-feet per annum, to be collected between \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of each season.

NOTE.—Answer (a) or (b) or both (a) and (b) as may be necessary. The amounts stated must be in definite terms of some established unit of measurement. Neither these amounts nor the season may be increased after application is filed.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is **recreational and fire protection** purposes.

NOTE.—A separate application must be made for each use except that incidental domestic use may be included with any other use.

4. The point of diversion is to be located **N. 4° 30' W., 1,130 ft.** from the quarter Section corner common to Section 34, T 7 S, R 4 W, and Section 3, T 8 S, R 4 W, M.D.B.&M. being within the **SE 1/4** of **SW 1/4** of Section **34**, Tp. **7 S**, R. **4 W M.D.B. & M.**, in the County of **San Mateo**

5. The main conduit terminates in **SW 1/4** of **SE 1/4** of Sec. 33, T. 7 S., R. 4 W M.D.B. & M.
